

## **Earlestown Bus Station**

### **Location**

Earlestown Bus Station is located on Tamworth Street, Lord Street and Legh St, close to the Town Hall and town centre. It is an unmanned bus station with 4 bus stands.

### **General Description**

The bus station has four bus stands situated on an oval shaped island accessed from 4 different crossing points; one at each end of the island and two in the middle. There is a railing around the whole perimeter of the island with gaps at the crossing points and to access the buses The Town Hall is situated on Tamworth St adjacent to one end of the bus station.

### **Layout**

With your back to the town hall on Tamworth St, the bus stands are located on the left and right of the island. Stands 1 and 2 are on the right of the island and 3 and 4 are on the left of the island. Each numbered stand has its own individual bus shelter which is made from glass panels and yellow metal posts. There are two openings one at the rear of the shelter to enter and the other at the front of the shelter to access the bus. They are rectangular in shape. The stand numbers are printed on the front of the bus stand itself although not very clearly.

There is a small seating area in each stand.

Immediately after stand 1 on your right and stand 4 on your left, there is a crossing point on each side of the island, indicated by a small section of tactile paving and a break in the railings. Also near this area is a customer help point located on a post in between the two sets of bus stands.

With your back to the town hall the buses enter the station on the right and leave on the left.
