Location

Heswall Bus Station is located on Telegraph Rd in the town centre opposite the Fire Station. It is an unmanned station.

General Description

The bus station has four bus stands situated on an oval shaped island accessed from crossing points with tactile paving on Telegraph Road at one end, and a zebra crossing at the Johnny Pye pub at the opposite end. There is a railing around the whole perimeter of the island with gaps at the crossing points and to access the buses.

Layout

With your back to Telegraph Road and standing on the bus station, the stands are located on the right and left of the island. The buses enter the station on the right, travel in a loop around the island and leave on the left. Stand A is mainly used for dropping off from incoming buses. In the centre of the island there is a seating area, clock post and information stands. At the point furthest from Telegraph Road at the end of the island, there is a circular covered area resembling a band stand, which is open to the elements all around and has a low railing around it with entrance and exit points to enable pedestrians to access the zebra crossing over the busway at the end of the island.

Bus stands A and B are located on the right hand side of the island, stands D and C on the left of the island. The stands have individual shelters that are rectangular in shape and have one open side adjacent to the road to access the bus and three sides of glass panels. There is a small seating area in each shelter. These are yellow in colour and are one continuous narrow seat situated at the rear of the shelter.
